This acknowledges receipt of your June 6, 2024 filing that includes a revised schedule for filing a surrender application for the Potter Valley Hydroelectric Project No. 77. The project is located on the Eel and East Fork Russian Rivers, in Lake and Mendocino Counties, California.

Background

The project license expired April 14, 2022. The Commission issued a Notice of Authorization for Continued Project Operation, on April 21, 2022. By letter issued May 11, 2022, Commission staff requested that you file a plan and schedule for filing a surrender application with the Commission. In your July 8, 2022 response, you originally proposed to file a surrender application by January 2025, which was acknowledged by Commission staff on July 29, 2022.
